Changes identified

- **External stakeholders**
 - Decision-makers better informed on nature of water/poverty relationship and mitigation strategies, and act on them
 - Provision of political support for the BFP and its findings
 - Target research and interventions on the real priority areas
 - Provision of additional funding support for the work
 - Disseminate project outputs, BFP researchers invited to present results
- **BFP Implementing organizations**
 - Better sharing of data, data sharing mechanism used
 - Stronger partnership with better capacity for interdisciplinary basin research



Strategies used

- Research collaboration – full interaction and mutual learning of the various research partners
- Co-development of outputs
- Development of MoUs
- Invitations to meetings, hosting of workshops
- Political lobbying
- Targeted communication with key stakeholders
- Develop regional data base acceptable to representatives of all riparian countries.
- Provide decision-makers with list of potential ag. water intervention packages validated with stakeholders
